### Review and Share Comments Online

With Acrobat 5.0, multiple users can view and add comments to the same Adobe PDF document from within their Web browsers, which can significantly accelerate the document review process. Graphics professionals can use Web-based document review cycles with their clients and colleagues, thereby saving money by reducing the costs associated with printing and approving comps.

**Work within a browser.** With Acrobat 5.0 installed, you can open Adobe PDF files from within a Web browser and access many Acrobat tools to comment on the document in the browser.

**Share comments online.** Sharing comments online can be implemented easily because the process works with a variety of standard protocols, such as WebDistributed Authoring and Versioning (WebDAV). If your workgroup doesn't already have a shared data repository, you can easily set one up using a shared network folder, ODBC, or Microsoft Office Server extensions. Acrobat lets you restrict printing entirely, not at all, or allow printing only at low resolution, among other options.
